You are welcome to hire a pint glass from us for the festival. We ask a £2.50 deposit, refundable upon return of the glass in good condition. Biodegradable plastic cups are also available.

We expect to have food available during all of the sessions, including the burger bar, filled rolls, pork pies and sausage rolls as well as bar snacks.
